The 2015 Stanton Vineyards Petite Sirah is everything you've come to expect from a Stanton Petite Sirah. It is deep, dark, rich and inky, with aromas of creamy mocha, toasted wood and ample chocolatey tannins. It comes on the heels of a great 2014 vintage which won Double Gold at the San Francisco Chronicle Wine Competition and again Double Gold "Best Petite Sirah in California" at the 2017 California State Fair.

It's harvest date of September 12 reflects a warm growing season coupled with a 25% reduction in the amount of fruit harvested from this block. A mere 239 cases produced!

We hope you enjoy drinking this wine as much as we enjoyed growing and producing it for you!
